Re: Partial Notice to Proceed with Buckeye Xpress Project Activities

Dear Mr. Jackson:

I grant your January 30, 2020 request, as modified on February 14, 2020, for Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (Columbia) to commence certain construction activities associated with the Buckeye Xpress Project. Specifically, Columbia may begin contractor mobilization and site preparation activities within the upland portions of the contractor yard/staging area sites and associated access roads, identified in its modified Table 1 of Columbia's Notice to Proceed Request. The requested contractor yard/staging area sites and associated access roads would have limited to no ground disturbance and no tree clearing. In considering this notice to proceed, we have reviewed your Implementation Plan filed on January 29, 2020, and the best management practices described in your application and subsequent filings. Based on our review, Columbia has provided the information necessary to meet the applicable pre-construction conditions of the Commission's January 23, 2020 *Order Issuing Certificate and Approving Abandonment* (Order) in the above-referenced docket. In addition, we have confirmed the receipt of all federal authorizations relevant to the activities approved herein.
